


UCARE (Urology Cancer Research and Education) was founded by a group of clinicians, patients and supporters who care about fighting urological cancer.

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Bladder Cancer



Be aware, be informed

Bladder cancer: be aware of the signs and symptoms

Bladder cancer affects both men and women and is a common cancer, with approximately

10,400 people diagnosed each year in the UK.


Symptoms

The most common symptom of bladder cancer is:

blood in the urine

Other less common symptoms are:

- pain when passing urine
- more frequent passing of urine
- getting up at night to pass urine



Diagnosis and treatment

Your doctor will arrange further investigations and, if appropriate, will refer you to hospital for further tests. This will often involve a CT scan and a cystoscopy (a thin tube passed into the bladder to enable examination) in order to reach a diagnosis.

If test results show you have bladder cancer, you will be referred to a team of specialists at the hospital, who will decide upon the correct course of treatment:

- Radiologists who help to analyse scans and x-rays
- Specialist Pathologist who will analyse the cancer tissue and advise on the type and extent of the cancer
- Surgeons who are experienced in bladder surgery
- Oncologists doctors who treat bladder cancer using radiotherapy and chemotherapy
- Specialist cancer nurses who give information and support

Clinical trials

You may be offered entry into a clinical trial. Clinical trials help to find out if treatments are safe or have any side effects. They help to establish whether new treatments are better than the standard available treatments.
