


UCARE (Urology Cancer Research and Education) was founded by a group of clinicians, patients and supporters who care about fighting urological cancer.


Kidney Cancer



Be aware, be informed

Kidney cancer: be aware of the signs and symptoms

The kidneys are two bean-shaped organs each about the size of a fist. They are situated just below the rib cage on either side of the spine. Every day, the kidneys filter waste products and fluid from the blood and turn it into urine. Kidney cancer is now the eighth most common cancer in the UK - over 10,100 cases each year.



Symptoms

Kidney cancer often causes no symptoms and is found as an incidental finding on a routine scan.

Specific symptoms include: Non-specific symptoms include:

- blood in the urine
- weight loss
- pain or swelling in the loin
- appetite loss
- fatigue
- night sweats

If you have any of these symptoms, you should see your doctor.

Diagnosis and treatment

Your doctor will arrange appropriate investigations and may refer you to hospital for further tests. If your test results show that you have kidney cancer, you will be looked after by a specialist multidisciplinary team at the hospital who will decide the correct treatment for you:

- Radiologists who help to analyse scans and x-rays
- Specialist pathologists who analyse the cancer tissue and advise on the type and extent of the cancer
- Surgeons who are experienced in kidney surgery
- Oncologists doctors who treat kidney cancer using chemotherapy and radiotherapy
- Specialist cancer nurses who give information and support

Following treatment you will be asked to go back to the hospital for regular check ups.

Clinical trials

You may be offered entry into a clinical trial. Clinical trials help to find out if treatments are safe or have any side effects. They help to establish whether new treatments are better than the standard available treatments.
